



Transylvania, Dracula & so much more...

Beyond myths and legends, Dracula and blood sucking vampires, Transylvania is without doubt one of Europe's best hidden secrets. We will depart from Cluj in the morning and after about 2.5 hours of driving will reach Sighisoara. It is considered to be the most beautiful medieval site in Romania and the city's historical center has been on the UNESCO World Heritage List for many years now. The two gothic churches, the narrow streets and old craftsmen houses preserve an old, medieval atmosphere. It is said that Count Dracula was born in one of these houses – how much of it is true, we can only find out by visiting this lovely little city

Next on our list is the small village Crit, where a local family has invited us to a „Transylvanian Brunch”. Mouthwatering homemade specialties, such as eggplant salad, local lard and sausages, as well as a selection of homegrown vegetables and fruits, will be shore to spoil us...

The region is also famous for the many fortified churches, built by the German Transylvanian communities between the 12th and 16th century against the barbaric invasions. These are some of Transylvania's most important and valuable trademarks... Of course, we will get the chance to visit one of them and learn more about the local history.

In the evening, just before dark, we will arrive in Bran. Millions of tourists visit the castle each year in search of the blood-sucking vampire, Graf Dracula. We will have the castle all to ourselves and during our private tour, we can ask our special guide more about the history and legends of this 14th century castle... Dinner will also be special: fine dine, served in the 100-year-old tea house that used to belong to the Romanian royal family...
